By now I am sure that everyone has received the packet, which was mailed to you concerning your financial support for the renovation of the church basement. I do hope that everyone can appreciate how very much this renovation is needed. Now it is time to focus on turning our basement facilities into something very special and attractive for all of us and for the many people that come as visitors to our parish for funerals, weddings, confirmations, and various meetings.

As I said in church last Sunday, this is a project that we all need to support, both with our prayers and our treasures. So please pray that the renovation can be accomplished in the best possible way so that we can have the use of this space to carry on the Mission of Jesus Christ and the Church.

I would again like to thank everyone for their continued generosity and support of our parish community. May God bless all of us as we try to follow in His Way.

Let's remember that our Parish Mission starts in just 8 days. Bishop Pevec will have much to share with us on the mission of Jesus. Bishop Pevec is a very kind and holy man with a wealth of experience from which we can learn much about Jesus and spreading the Good News. I might add that he is also a very good speaker, so I hope that you will be able to join us for all or at least part of our Parish Mission.

You may have noticed that I have been trying to talk more and more about evangelization lately. As I have said before this is a major theme of Pope John Paul II's preaching. On Thursday, April 11, we will begin a special program called "**CATHOLICS RETURNING HOME.**" You may see signs and posters about this program around town and even in some people's front lawns, as well as in the newspaper and on our local cable TV stations.

We as a parish must try to make every effort to reach out and invite family members, friends, neighbors, fellow workers, fellow students, or anyone that we know who is Catholic to come home to the Church. So, give it some thought and prayer and join in the new evangelization by inviting some one to "come home." They will be glad they did and so will you and so will God!
