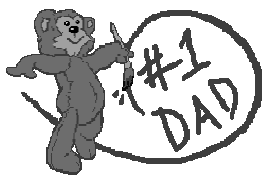
### ATTENTION: ALL ACTIVE, AUXILIARY, & JUNIOR LEGION OF MARY MEMBERS

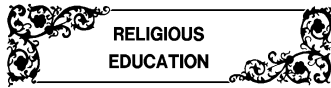
